(Hep A 1 st dose, Hep B, Yellow Fever, Typhoid, Tetanus) – approx. \$425 per person; 2) Kenya Program Fee ~\$1800-1900 (to Kenya Relief); 3) Airfare inc trip insurance (PO to Kenya Relief, who pays travel agent) ~\$1650 4) Participants to purchase anti-malarial (\$ varies) and Kenyan Visa ~\$51
Pre-Departure Meeting to discuss Itinerary, Packing, Money, What to Expect while on Tour (US and International flights, immigration and customs, arrival in Nairobi, travel to Kenya Relief facilities in Migori, living arrangements, meals, climate, customs, etc.), Clinic and/or Project Expectations, Packing, etc.
